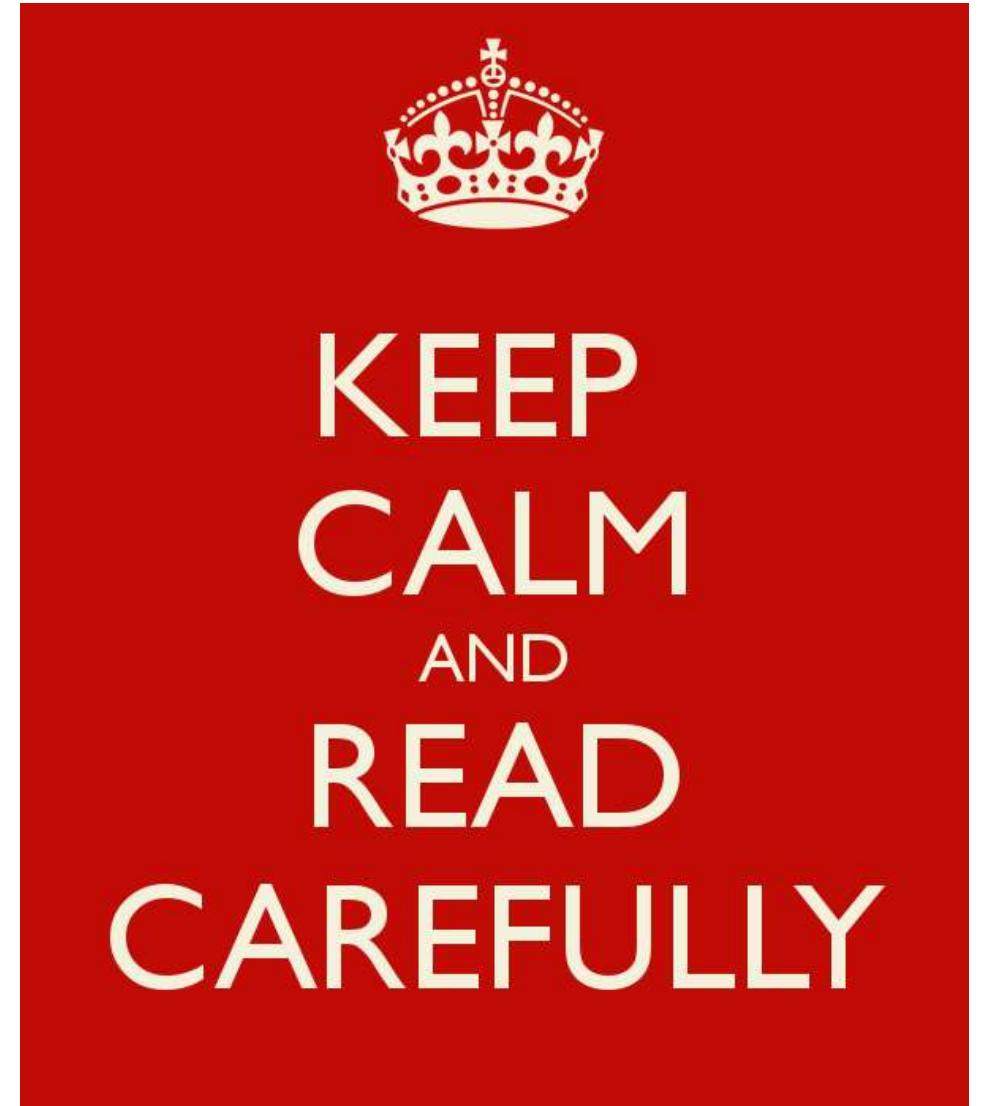




- Your teachers spend a lot of time, care and energy marking your work.

Look carefully at what your teacher recommends as your next step target.



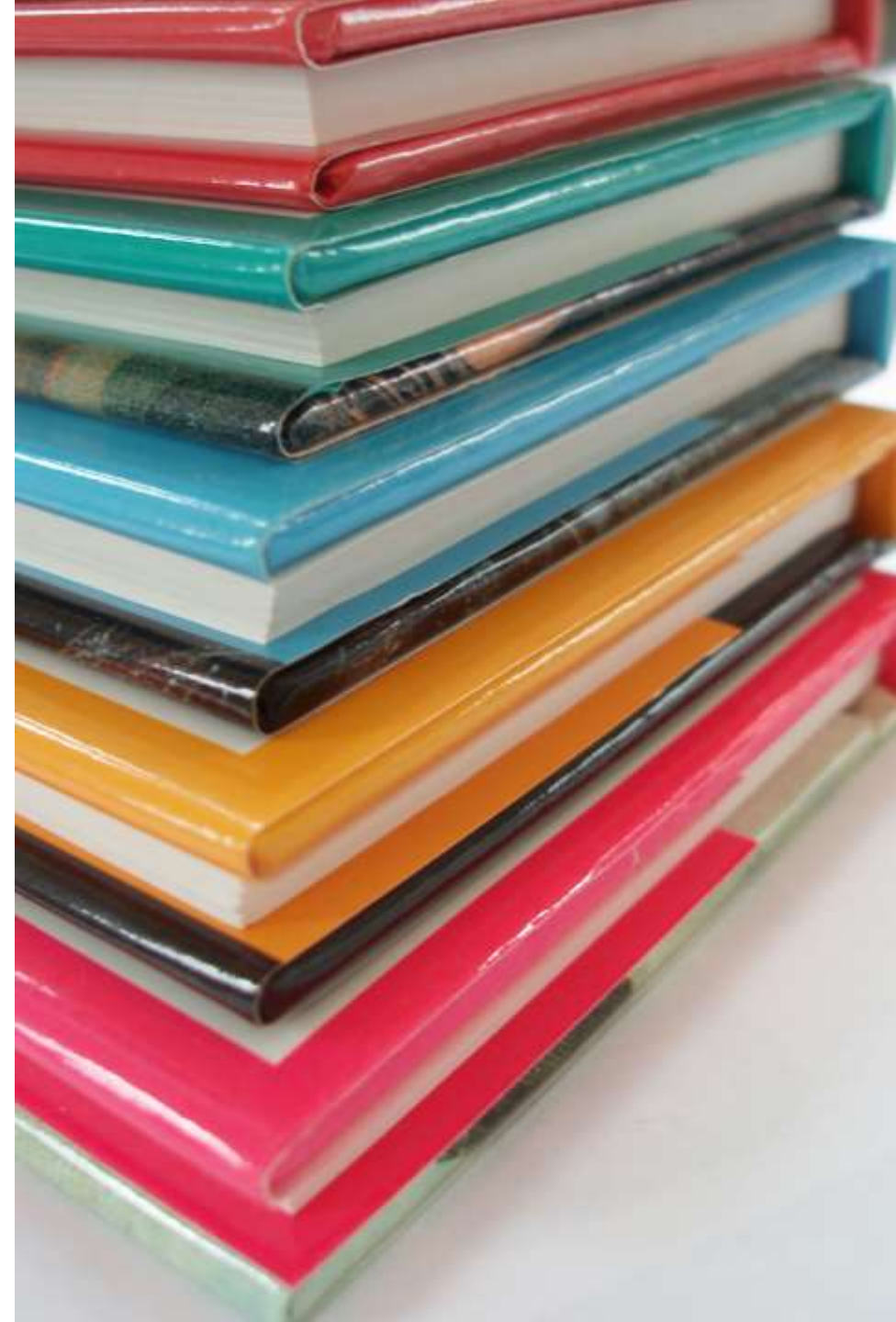
What you need to do regarding this feedback:

Ensure that you understand this target. If you are not sure, ask!

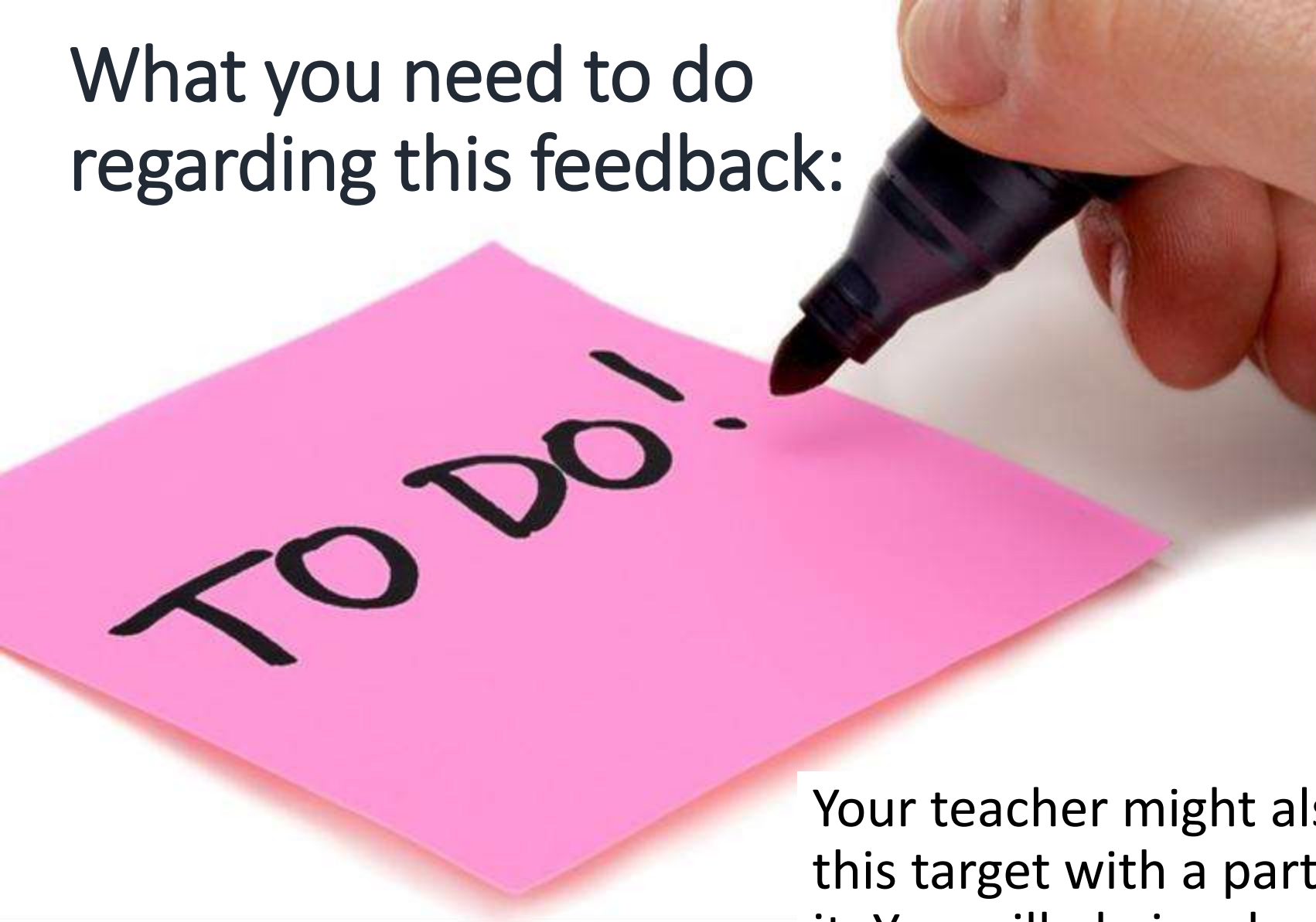


What you need to do regarding this feedback:

Note the next step target in your exercise book or file. Your teacher will tell you where and how to note this down. All departments have set approaches to this, but they differ from subject to subject.

Your teacher might also suggest that you discuss this target with a partner or friend. Engage with it. You will obviously do much better in your next piece of work if you have a clear idea of what you need to achieve and how to go about it.

What you need to do regarding this feedback:

Understand how your next step target fits into the GCSE mark scheme.



What you need to do regarding this feedback:

Discuss your feedback and your target at home. This discussion is part of you engaging with the feedback. If you can explain to your parents what you need to do next and why then you have a much better chance of actually achieving it.



What you need to do regarding this feedback:

Look at the next step target again before your next major piece of work. Check that you have addressed it before you hand that next piece of work in.
