Art private study work will be set after one double lesson per fortnight. Drama and Music will set private study tasks as appropriate. Private study work may occasionally be set following a Computing lesson.

French and German as well as Religious Education lessons are timetabled on different days of the week for different students. Students studying two languages will be set private study work once each week for each language; students studying one language may be set work twice during the week. All students will be set RE work once a week.

A student who thinks that no specific task has been set should refer to the list of generic Private Study tasks for that subject in their exercise book or folder.

#### With reference to their own individual timetables, students should personalise the above private study timetable by creating their own version below as follows:

- Identify the specific Science subjects and put "Biology", "Chemistry" and "Physics" rather than "Science".
- Put *three* private study slots onto their timetable for French and/or German and RE.
- Ensure an even distribution of work throughout the week (usually three tasks per night). Students cannot change the days on which work is **set** or **due**, but can opt to do the work on any evening. It is generally advisable to do the tasks as soon as possible after they have been set, to ensure that teacher help can be sought if a student is unsure about a specific task.
- Check: You should have 14 private study slots in total.
