

How to use inktense pencils



Tickle the paper with colour. Don't put too much on.



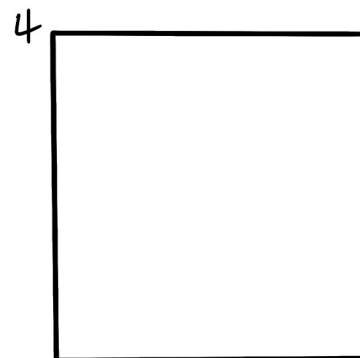
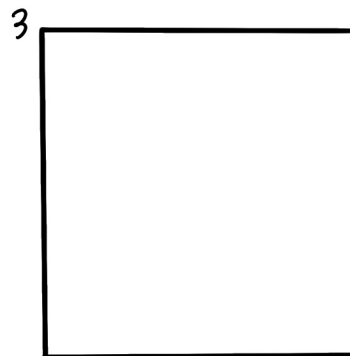
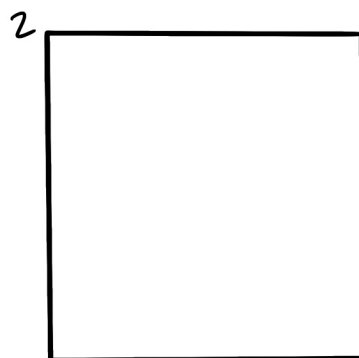
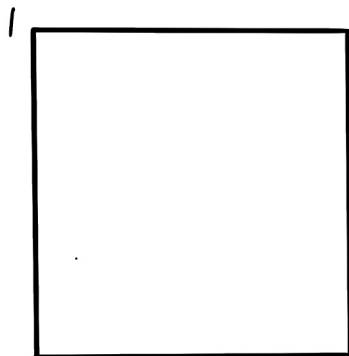
Merge the inktense colours with small wet brush marks.



Add more inktense once each layer has dried, build up the form + add more water.



Add fine details with sharpened inktense. Stroke with clean brush + add white highlights. (add black fine liner if necessary.)



You will need: 1, 4 inktense colours light to dark.

2, A shell

3, A retractable pencil

4, A rubber

5, A size 2 paintbrush

6, A tissue

7, white acrylic or gouache

8, 170gsm cartridge paper

Remember

1, layer up your colour from light to dark.

2, Don't put too much on.

3, leave areas of paper white

Key Terms

white space - Leave some of the paper white! Its easy for highlights to get lost when using watercolour. Its best to build up colour slowly, leaving some of the paper white to keep the form.
